

# Creator God

(Sermon Notes) By Warren Zehrung 6/20/2015

We find ourselves living in an increasingly Godless society. Yet, way down deep I still believe that there are many people who lament the direction in which our nation is headed. When I watch the 'Politically Correct' evening news anchor-person, and then compare his or her thoughts, ideology and philosophy with those of my neighbors, it is clear that their views are diametrically opposed. This predictable dichotomy spawns an accompanying reaction.

Those who **welcome** broadening worldviews tend to promote the important role of schools in influencing the next generation. At the same time those of us who are more inclined to hold onto traditional values see the family as primary and vital to the transmission of moral standards.

The trend over the past half century has definitely tipped the scales towards influences outside the home as the main vehicles by which young people develop their moral code. There is definitely a powerful movement in government, media, and even in our schools to 'liberate' everyday Americans from anything and everything having to do with our **Creator God**.

There is a concerted effort to assail and assault everything having to do with morality, virtue, goodness and decency, and consign them to the past. ...Consigning them to the past **dark-ages**, as the progressives would view our culture. Because morality and belief in God are being done away with...

Cheating, crime, Godlessness, abuse and unfaithfulness are winked at and considered to be **personal choices** and **rights** of every citizen.

To those so-called progressive movers and shakers – there is no truth – only relativism – a view that **ethical truth** depends on the whims and impulses of the individuals and groups holding them.

Man was created to have a relationship with his Creator God. God the Father and Jesus Christ desire to have, and are in the process of creating an eternal spiritual family. The Bible reveals that man was created just for that purpose.

There is no doubt that we live in a world of declining morality. Over the years we have often cited the steady – and sometimes rapid – decline in moral standards all around us. We have noticed that those people who are rejecting God, view the breaking down of barriers and moral taboos as **progress** towards a freer, liberating and more tolerant society.

We in God's Church recognize this disturbing downhill slide to be a sign of the end-time. Jesus said that:

Matthew 24:12 ...because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Paul said it this way to Timothy:

2Timothy 3:1 This know also, that in the last days **perilous** times shall come.

Yes, these are dangerous and hostile times for true Christians.

2Timothy 3:2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

2Timothy 3:3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

2Timothy 3:4 Traitors, heady, highminded, **lovers of pleasures** more than lovers of God;

Lovers of "ease and pleasure" – that has become their god. (little g) Appreciation for the countless blessings that have been bestowed by our **Creator God** on this once-great country are becoming a thing of the past. We find ourselves in a society filled with iniquity that Jesus describes as being, "Like the days of Noah before the flood." We are told that:

Genesis 6:5 God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only **evil continually**...

Matthew 24:37 But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

Matthew 24:38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark.

The clear inference is that they were **lovers of pleasures** more than lovers of God. Our nation is rapidly turning away from, and forgetting our **Creator God**. Who today relies on the word of God in the conduct of their daily business? Who yet believes that the Bible is the true word of God in writing? We are so blessed to have our very own copies of God's Word – most of mankind has not been so privileged as we are in that respect.

Every time someone is thrust into the public eye, if they profess a semblance of Christianity, they are relegated to the status of foolish buffoons by the press. Today's 'Political Correctness' demands that religious people be treated as though they were backward, uninformed and even dangerous to themselves and society.

This evil world does not realize that we stand at the edge of the precipice. Our Israelitish nations are about to fall – – **again**. Surely, the status of our culture today mimics that of ancient Israel as they were about to be carried away into captivity and lost from the view of the world. Israel went into captivity and bondage because they forsook God's Sabbath and turned to other gods. They forgot their **Creator God**.

Ours is a very hostile environment in which to preach the Gospel message of the soon coming Kingdom of God to be established on earth. And yet God is calling a few at this eleventh hour into assemblies in which they are able to grow spiritually and become His children. You can read the example where Jesus explains that those who are called near the very end of the age will receive a full reward in Matthew 20:1-16.

Increasingly, those being called by God are coming out of a deranged and Godless society. They, too, must learn that the word of God is the foundation of knowledge, because that is the only basis on which to build a Godly life. It is only within the pages of Scripture that they will find the proper tools to erect the structure of a Christian life. With that Godly wisdom and understanding, the entire population of the world would be changed. But, not yet. That will only come with Christ in the millennium.

The way of this present evil world does not offer the structure of a Christian life. We live in a hardened and calloused society without a loving Creator God to guide and lead us. A permissive society that gloats on perversions, transgender preferences, and destruction of the Godly **family unit** are bringing broken homes, mental pain, divorce, mob violence, increased suicides and destruction. And it will only get worse without the proper **tools** to begin to establish Christian lives.

Those proper tools are God's spiritual **principles** that are to be sought out and used daily. God's principles are for our use today – and not reserved just for the Kingdom of God tomorrow.

Do we really comprehend how great our Creator God is? He is so much greater than the vast majority of mankind supposes. God's word reveals that God's greatness is too wonderful for man's heart. God knows our every thought. God is not somewhat like a man that we might contend with Him, because His power is limitless and He is all knowing.

Numbers 23:19 God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

God is not mocked by those with ulterior motives.

Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man sows, that shall he also reap.

Psalms 145:3 Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable.

God's ways are past the comprehensive abilities of our very limited minds. The vast limitless outer space of the universe with its billions of years of time gone by attest to how immeasurably great our Creator God is.

Likewise the deep inner space of the sub atomic world of unfathomable matter is **evidence** of how impossible it is for man to compare himself to our Loving Father and His Son, Jesus Christ, by whom He created all things.

Scientists, while shoving God into the background, try to 'recreate' everything – even life itself unsuccessfully – but pat themselves on the back when they crack a small part God's DNA creation code.

Specific Purpose Statement: In today's sermon we are exploring how Jesus has revealed Himself as **Creator God** so that we might know and stand in wonder and awe of Him. At what depth of **knowledge, understanding, wisdom** and **Godly wisdom** do we comprehend the term, "Creator God?"

When you picture in your mind's eye our **Creator God**, just what do you picture? Perhaps, God creating the vast universe...? God is certainly big and powerful; but there is **so much more** to our Creator God – isn't there? Not just the rocks, moons, planets and stars...

Isaiah 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that **created** the **heavens**; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it **to be inhabited**: I am the LORD; and there is none else.

"Inhabited" because God is creating an eternal spiritual family.

Nehemiah 9:6 Thou, even thou, art LORD alone; **thou** hast **made heaven**, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and **all** that is **therein**, and thou preserve them all; and the host of heaven worship thee.

Who created light and heat? Brethren, our Creator God is the creator of the much more important and precious **spiritual** creation of which we have been called to be a part. Who created life and emotion and feelings? Who created law and happiness? Who created eternal spiritual principles that work everywhere and for all time? Who created the Godly traits of **mercy** and **forgiveness**?

Romans 11:32 For God has concluded them all [the world] in unbelief, that He might have **mercy** upon all.

Do not think only of the physical creation when you picture our Creator God, but rather add to your conception a creator of all Godly virtues.

Romans 11:36 For of him [God], and through him, and to him, are **all things** [all things consist and exist]: to whom be glory forever. Amen.

God is the author and creator of all virtuous and moral attributes: For the express purpose that by these ye might be partakers of the **divine nature**.

Who created **righteousness** and judgment and moral attributes like ...knowledge; meekness, temperance, patience, godliness, peaceableness, gentleness, brotherly kindness; and charity?

Psalms 33:5 He loves righteousness and judgment: the earth is **full** of the goodness of the LORD.

Psalms 33:6 By the **word** of the LORD were the **heavens made**; and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.

The word 'inspired' means, breath of His mouth. The Bible is God breathed.

Psalms 33:7 He gathers the waters of the sea together as an heap: he lays up the depth in storehouses.

Psalms 33:8 Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.

Of the seven billion inhabitants of the earth, six point ninety-nine billion do not stand in awe of the true God.

Psalm 33:9 For he spoke, and it [all creation] was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.

How do we avail ourselves of the traits, attributes and character of our Creator God?

Biblical **knowledge** comes first: First, we begin to accumulate **facts** from the Bible – that is knowledge. **Understanding** comes next: We learn to interpret that Scriptural knowledge with ever increasing discernment – that is understanding. Next on the scale of Godly growth and development comes **wisdom**. When we choose the right **source** [God’s word] for our instruction, we are able to become skilled at applying that correct understanding – that is wisdom. With **conversion** we go one step farther that we might be partakers of God’s divine nature. Then, with God’s **Holy Spirit**, it is possible to build the exceptional character that accompanies Godly Wisdom.

2Timothy 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the **holy scriptures**, which are able to **make thee wise** unto **salvation** through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Having the highest respect for God and His Way is the beginning of wisdom.

Proverbs 1:7 The reverence of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge.

James, the brother of Jesus Christ describes the **traits** of Godly wisdom.

James 3:13 Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him show out of a good conduct his works with meekness of **wisdom**.

Then James gives an example of man’s **counterfeit** wisdom.

James 3:14 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

James 3:15 This [counterfeit] wisdom descends **not from above** [it is not of God], but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

James 3:16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

Then James tells us what Godly wisdom consists of:

James 3:17 But the **wisdom that is from above** [Godly wisdom] is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

Throughout the pages of the Bible, God reveals Himself to us as our **Creator God**.

Proverbs 4:5 Get **wisdom**, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

Proverbs 4:6 Forsake her not [wisdom personified], and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep thee.

Proverbs 4:7 Wisdom is the **principal thing**; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.

In all of this we are overlooking one important **fact** – and that is that we must first be **called** by God and experience His **intervention** in our lives. Nothing can be proven from the Bible without the **gift** that only God can give us – that of knowing that the Bible **is** the word of God. We can prove it for ourselves – but we cannot prove it to an unbeliever. God speaks to us through His words in the Bible. Every writer of the 66 books of the Bible, holy men of old, was directly inspired through God’s Spirit to write down the very words and thoughts we have in our Bible.

2Peter 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

That is our **starting** point: The Bible is the word of God. In Hebrew the name used for “God” is the name Elohim which reveals the mighty strength of God. Isaiah speaks of God in His capacity as Creator God – and how great He is.

Isaiah 40:10 Behold, the Lord GOD will come with strong hand, and his arm shall rule for him: behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

Isaiah 40:11 He shall feed his flock like **a shepherd**: he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom [tenderly and gently], and shall gently lead those that are with young.

Isaiah 40:12 Who hath measured the waters [think- Pacific Ocean] in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with a yard stick [Billions of light-years across], and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance?

I have found that **everyone** wants to serve God – the problem is that they only want to serve Him in an advisory capacity. That is what Isaiah records in this next verse:

Isaiah 40:13 Who hath directed the Spirit of the LORD, or being His **counselor** hath taught him?

God is never in need of counsel, and He does not lack in Godly Wisdom. God is trustworthy and faithful.

Romans 11:34 For who hath known the mind of the Lord? Or who hath been his **counselor**? [No one has.]

Isaiah 40:14 With whom took he counsel, and who instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and showed to him the way of understanding?

Isaiah 40:15 Behold, the **nations** are as one drop of water in a bucket, and are counted as the **small dust** in the weight scales [amounting to nothing]: behold, he takes up the isles as a very little thing.

Isaiah 44:6 Thus saith the LORD **the King of Israel**, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last [alpha and omega in the Greek]; and **beside me** there is no **God**.

Isaiah 44:8 Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; **I know not any**.

And God knows everything. When God says “**I know not any**” – that means **God is the only True God**. There are pretentious gods who make unjustified or excessive claims.

Jeremiah 10:11 Thus shall ye say unto them, The gods that have **not** made the heavens and the earth, even they shall perish from the earth, and from under these heavens.

Jesus Christ is the **Creator God**.

Jeremiah 10:12 He hath **made the earth** by his power, he hath established the world by his **wisdom**, and hath stretched out the heavens by his discretion.

Jeremiah 10:13 When he uttereth his voice, there is a multitude of waters in the heavens, and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth; he makes lightnings with rain, and brings forth the wind out of his treasures.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Genesis 5:1 ...In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him.

Genesis 1:26 And God said, **Let us make man in our image**, after our likeness:

Genesis 1:27 So God **created** man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Isaiah 66:1 Thus says the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? And where is the place of my rest?

Ask yourselves, “What is God looking for?” He desires truly converted sons and daughters.

Isaiah 66:2 For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, says the LORD: but to this man **will I look**, even to him that is **poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembles at my word**.

Love God and neighbor unto the fulfillment of God’s Plan. Jesus Christ is the **hands-on** Creator God. Jesus created everything at the direction of God the Father. It is Christ who carries out the will of His Father in everything He does. Life is created by God.

Genesis 1:27: So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female He created them. [Every second of our continuing existence is owing to the word of God.]

Ephesians 3:4 Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ.

Ephesians 3:5 Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

We, in these last days have been given it all.

Ephesians 3:9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in **God**, who **created all things by Jesus Christ**:

Ephesians 3:10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

Ephesians 3:11 According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:

All things came into being through Jesus Christ, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

John 1:3 All things were **made by him**; and without him was not anything made that was made.

Let's go to Colossians and see again that Jesus is the "Hands on Creator God."

Colossians 1:16 For by Him [Jesus Christ] were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

Colossians 1:17 And he is before all things, and **by him all things consist**.

Colossians 1:18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

Down through the ages, men were not so blessed as we are. Jesus said:

Matthew 13:16 But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear.

Matthew 13:17 For verily I say unto you, That many prophets and righteous men have desired to see those things which ye see, and have not seen them; and to hear those things which ye hear, and have not heard them.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is [God exists], and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Hebrews 1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers [the patriarchs] by the prophets. [There it is again.]

Hebrews 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom He hath appointed heir of all things, **by whom also He made the worlds**;

Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things [the universe] by the word of His power, when he had purged sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.

Yes, Jesus created this temporary physical universe:

Hebrews 1:10 And, Thou, Lord [Jesus Christ], in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thy hands:

Hebrews 1:11 They shall perish; but thou remain; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment;

"But thou remain" – Jesus Christ is eternal; whereas the physical universe waxes old – through entropy winds down and wastes away. God had plans for a different creation that will not waste away.

Hebrews 1:12 And as a vesture shall thou **fold them up** [you can fold a shirt – but how will the vast heavens of stars be folded up?], and **they shall be changed**: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail.

Paul expands on the time when this universe as we see it now will all be changed in a **glorious** way that will not ever waste away:

Romans 8:18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

There will be an entirely new heaven and earth for the eternal sons and daughters of God.

Romans 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creation waits for the manifestation of the sons of God.

Romans 8:20 For the creation was made subject to vanity [and entropy], not willingly, but by reason of Him who hath subjected the same in hope,

From the very beginning, God never meant for these fleshly physical bodies to exist forever. He has something so much better in store for His children.

Romans 8:21 Because the creation itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption [wasting away in entropy - gradually declining into disorder] into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Romans 8:22 For we know that the whole creation groans and travails in pain together until now.

Romans 8:23 And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.

Revelation 4:11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for thou hast **created all things**, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Revelation 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth **were passed away**; and there was no more sea.

Revelation 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Revelation 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

Revelation 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Revelation 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, **I make all things new**. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.

There is going to be a bold new universe. When we look out at the stars on a brilliant night we see a vast magnificent creation that **only** God could bring about. The interesting thing is that we are seeing the stars as they existed millions of years ago. It has taken the light from those stars **all this time** just to arrive at the earth. [At 186,000 miles per second, the speed of light!] The Bible clearly tells us that everything that we see is about to be **rearranged** by God in a spectacular way. The prophet Isaiah was inspired by God to let us know how this renewal of the universe is going to take place.

Isaiah 34:4 And all the host of heaven [the stars] shall be dissolved, and the heavens shall be **rolled together as a scroll**: and all their host shall fall down, as the leaf falls off from the vine, and as a falling fig from the fig tree.

Isaiah 5:30 And in that day they shall roar against them like the roaring of the sea: and if one look unto the land, behold darkness and sorrow, and the light is darkened in the heavens thereof.

Isaiah 51:6 Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: for the **heavens shall vanish** away like smoke, and the **earth shall wax old** like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation shall be forever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished.

This thought is reiterated by John in the Book of Revelation:

Revelation 6:14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

2Peter 3:2 That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Savior:

Silly scientists try to envision a universe without a **Creator God** – but all to no avail.

2Peter 3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,

2Peter 3:4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. [they are saying, “nothing has changed = nothing is going to change.”]

How wrong they are! They cannot open their eyes to the truth: They are not willing to admit that the earth was already destroyed once before by the great flood sent by God on an evil and unbelieving world.

2Peter 3:5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:

2Peter 3:6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, **perished**:

2Peter 3:7 But the heavens and the earth, which are **now**, by the same word are kept in store, **reserved unto fire** against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

2Peter 3:8 But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

This is one of the verses that tell us how long the millennium is going to be.

2Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

2Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

2Peter 3:11 Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, **what manner of persons ought ye to be** in all holy conduct and godliness,

It all comes down to living Godly lives – by serving God and our fellow man.

2Peter 3:12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the **heavens being on fire** shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

2Peter 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for **new** heavens and a new earth, wherein dwells righteousness.

2Peter 3:14 Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless. That is the only way to live – in peace, without spot, and blameless - if we expect to reign and rule with Jesus Christ for 1000 years.

Psalms 96:5 For all the gods of the nations are idols: but **the LORD made the heavens**.

Isaiah 37:15 And Hezekiah prayed unto the LORD [in fear of being conquered by Sennacherib], saying,

Isaiah 37:16 O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, that dwells between the cherubims, thou art the God, even thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth: **thou hast made heaven and earth.**

God heard Hezekiah's prayer and turned back Sennacherib and the kings of Assyria.

Psalm 8:3 When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, **which thou hast ordained;**

Psalm 8:4 What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visit him?

Psalm 8:5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honor.

Psalm 8:6 Thou made him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet:

Psalm 8:7 All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field;

Psalm 8:8 The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, and whatsoever passeth through the paths of the seas.

Psalm 8:9 O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth!

Psalm 100:3 Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

Psalm 139:13 For thou hast possessed my reins [formed my inner parts]: thou hast covered [woven] me in my mother's womb.
